

There are few automobiles in the world as iconic as Porsche's air-cooled sports cars. For more than 50 years Porsche's rear-engine wonders set the benchmark for production sports cars and dominated the world's race courses. From the first Gmund coupe, to the 356 to the timeless 911, this richly illustrated volume tells the full story of Germany's fabled sports cars. Automotive writer and photographer Dennis Adler begins the book with the early career of Ferdinand Porsche, detailing the influences and events that set him on the path of automotive-engineering greatness including key stints with Mercedes-Benz, Auto Union, and Volkswagen. From there he details Porsche's WWII work before moving into the postwar era and the establishment of Porsche as a unique automotive brand. Adler's engaging text is accompanied throughout by rare images from Porsche's historic archive as well as stunning contemporary photos of all the great cars including 356 Carrera, 550 Speedster, 911S, 912, 930 Turbo, 914/6 as well as key racers like the 906, 908, and 935.

For those (including myself) who have a copy of the author's monograph "Porsche The Road from Zuffenhausen" (Random House 2003), and who (?foolishly) went ahead and pre-ordered this "new" monograph, consider yourself hood-winked. This is a somewhat artlessly updated version of the earlier book, minus 40 or so pages of content in the earlier book, sporting the same introduction from 2003, and absent the names of owners in the captions accompanying photos of many of the beautiful 356's and early 911's. A note from the publisher and seller indicating this is a revised/abbreviated version of the 2003 monograph with a different publisher should have accompanied the spiel and I would have saved a few bucks. As best I can ascertain there is minimal new content and failure to update the introduction is a big flub, since the 911 is now more than five decades old, not four per the introduction in the "new" book. Bit of a shameless double dip Mr Adler and co. On a positive note, the 2003 monograph is out of print but can be purchased through our host, and for those who do not have "The Road from Zuffenhausen" this is a good book at a decent

price point.
