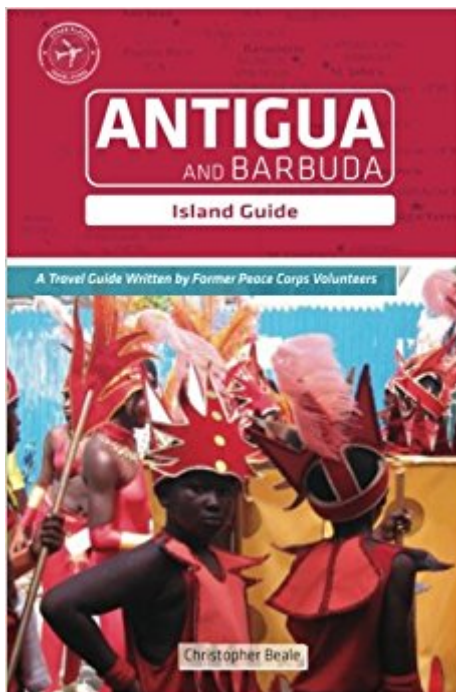

We used this book along with "Rough Guide Directions Antigua and Barbuda" by Adam Vaitilingam, between the two books, they formed a fairly comprehensive guide to the country, it's history, how things work from Taxi's and other public transportation, the airport, the roads and rental cars, etc...I found this book to be more of a story about living on the island, and the other more of a directory of services, but both have valuable information to offer up. It was nice to read both books prior to our

trip, and also to have them on hand while we were there. It really is a beautiful country with some very friendly people. I strongly suggest using these books along with a rental car (although, as the books will warn, it's a bit crazy driving on the island, but we survived to tell the story) and seeing all that the country has to offer. I was truly amazed at how few of the guests at our resort had rental cars (me and 4 others) everyone else either stayed on the resort property or just took the organized tours, if you're going to do this, you don't need the books. If you want to experience the island for yourself, get out and meet the people, see what lies off the beaten path, grab this book and one or two others, and go out and explore, you'll be happy you did. FYI, we were there February 2015, apparently in November of last year a strong storm did some extensive damage to the island, including wiping out nearly all of their street signs. Many are still laying on the ground, some have been propped back up, but not always in their proper locations, and most are just gone or never existed. While there are basic maps in both of these books, if you're going to drive, invest in a decent map or pre-load a GPS with the island before you go, it'll make life easier. We had neither, but still managed to get around, just took some unexpected detours and scenic rides.

I bought this book as a gift for someone going to Antigua in January. I was disappointed at the poor quality of the paper thin cover and the poor quality of paper for the pages. It has no pictures. Not attractive at all. It was a poor choice for a gift. I did not read the book so I can not comment on the contents. Just not a good gift.
