

For details relating to route descriptions, photos, and practical info for the specific region I find this guide the best. It is very well written from its descriptions of the various main and side treks to the feel within the teahouse lodges. I have not been there yet so I can't verify the accuracy but I'm very impressed. I have been posting to Lonely Planet's Thorn Tree asking about various alternative trekking routes and have had some posters who had already been there say they didn't even know those options existed. The book is also smaller than some guides and the paper quality seems superior to the others. It's great to see some beautiful color photos.
