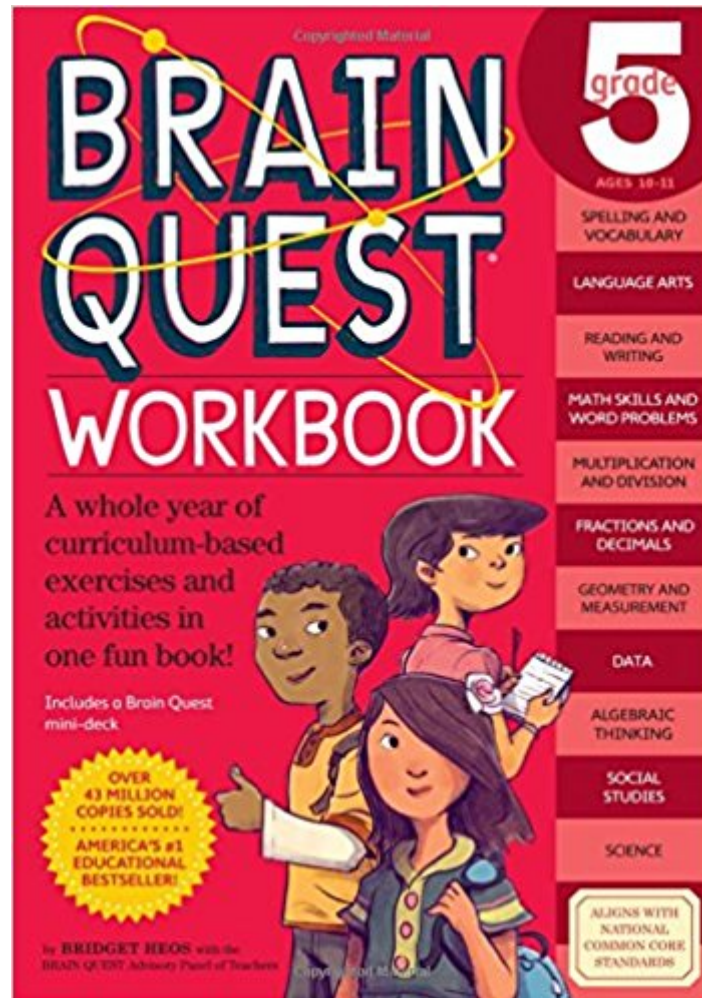

I've ordered these the past few years to help supplement with our home schooling and have found although not thorough enough in all areas of instruction is is a great starter and is easy for my child to complete and understand most lessons on his own. It's great for review and to brush up and master skills. It's not overwhelming at all and is pretty simple. I luv the brain boxes in the corner on the pages that help refresh and jog memory of a skill so kids are not lost or have to look back to find what was previously covered. The answer key in the back of the book is great too.

Lots of great problems and Brain Teasers if you have a child that loves to be challenged! We go this for our rising 4th grader and were unsure if he would be able to do all the work in here. To our surprise, he was able to do many of the problems in the book. He wasn't able to do all of them as there are some things he'll learn this year, but we expected that and were able to give him a preview of the topics he'd need to pay more attention to. This is a great book for advanced 4th graders through 4th graders.

My kids moaned and groaned doing the work book they had last summer so decided to give this one a try. While my daughter still complained she did this one more easily and the work seemed more in line with what she was doing in school the previous year. I liked the boxes at the bottom of the worksheets that explained each concept so I didn't have to wrack my brain trying to remember the concepts she couldn't recall from school.

This book was a good fit to keep kids using their brains during the summer. It was was pretty easy to use, and had good variety of topics. One criticism, at least one of the crosswords seemed overly challenging. We needed to get a thesaurus to figure them out. One of the answers was DIN - do any 5th graders use the word 'din' anymore? I don't hear that word very often even as an adult, but maybe it is just me.

This is one of the better workbooks that i have found. We do a lot of these in the summer so the kids are still productive. My 10 year old has been very busy and excited about all the new things to learn in preparation for grade 5!

Fantastic, and interesting practice workbook for my son for the summer. Each page comes with an explanation on the side and answers are in the back. My son can do it independently and I can check it later.

Every summer I buy a BrainQuest book. During summer almost every weekday I assign my son two pages from each section. It takes him about an hour to go through 16-18 pages and he doesn't really mind doing it. Brain Boxes and questions seem well designed and educational while still appealing to a child. I am happy with the series.

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
