

Frequently critical of the official response to the hurricane, Miller explores the racist component of the federal government's lack of effective action, as well as favoritism in the bidding and awarding of FEMA reconstruction contracts. Sidebars present additional and often unexpected details, while color photos illustrate the devastation and aftermath.
