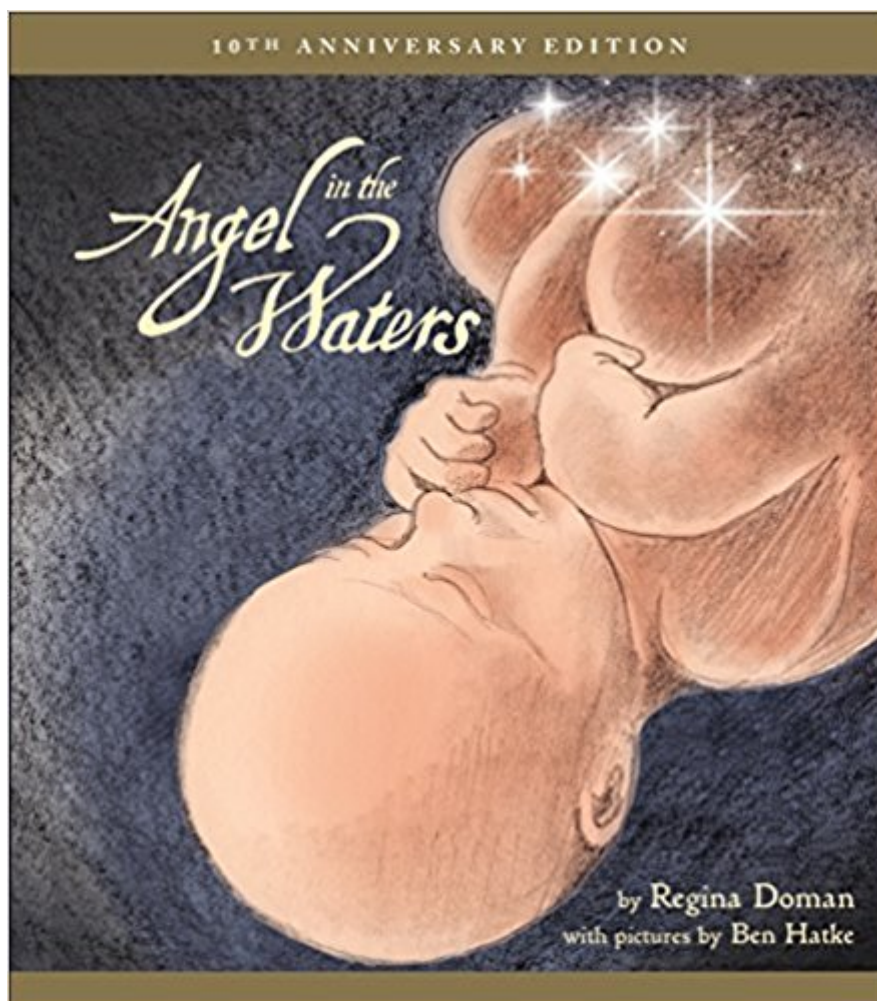

The language is simple but not boring, and it reads with such a nice cadence. The illustrations are beautiful. And what I loved most about it is that while it talks about an "angel" there's never any religious reference to it so it was easy for me to talk about in a non-religious way with my daughter. I gifted this book to my midwife because it quickly became a favorite, and I recommend it to all my pregnant friends with older kids who are looking for good books. It's just one of the loveliest books I've ever read, and my daughter agrees!
