

He is the author of Mitchell Beazley's Wines of South America which recently won the James Beard Foundation Best Wine & Spirits Book of the Year 2004. He has also written Biodynamic Wines part of Mitchell Beazley's Classic Wine Library and the Organic Wine Guide (Thorsons). He has been nominated for the Prix du Champagne Lanson and Glenfiddich drinks writing awards for his contributions to publications such as Harpers, Wine International, and Decanter. Terrific book! Well written

My purchase was advertised as "new" condition, which I suppose is relative for a book that was

published in 2006. However, I question the storage of the book, which directly impacted its condition. The actual book I received was hardly pristine. The cover has impressions in it, and the pages are slightly discolored. The book also has a noticeably musty smell. While none of this affects the readability, I do feel a bit deceived by the seller. Sure, not enough to return the book and request my money back, but enough to ensure I'm more careful about 3rd party sellers through the network. As for the content of the book, it's a wonderful resource for anyone looking to assist in researching what to do on their trip to the Bordeaux region.
