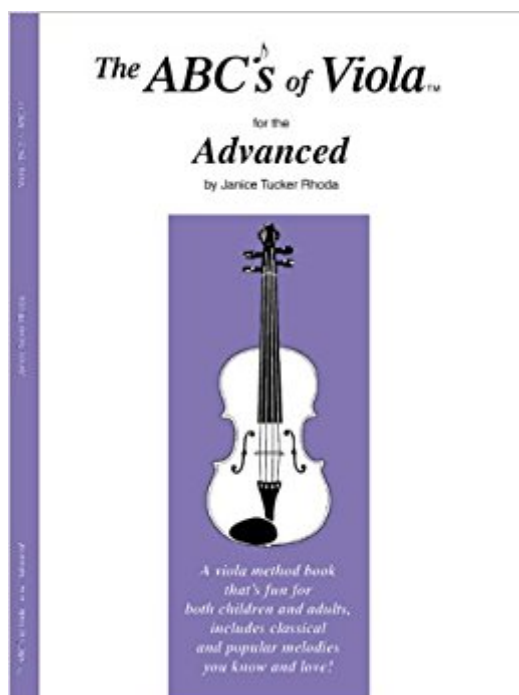


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The ABCs Of Viola For The Advanced, Book 3

I had bought this book on a recommend. I am very pleased with the content and layout of the 16 lessons. At the back of the book there is also a page of blank alto score staves and two pages of a 'Practice Planner' suitably labeled. This book is presented in a large format 9x12, glossy cover, with easy to read, clearly written lessons. The type font is large and bold, great for reading while holding a full size viola. The graphics are simple and clarify the finger pattern to be used in the lesson. Each lesson spells out what the topic is as a subtitle; e.g. 'Lesson 11, Third Position On The G-String'. Other helpful features for the student are: * Counting hints on the first measure * Metronome settings along with the tempo * Information regarding time signature meaning * Each practice piece is numbered for easy reference * Lesson notes as needed. Also, I like how the format and spacing of the content is clear and not crowded. As a footnote to the first lesson there is a reference to "Easy Piano Accompaniment for Book 3". My only regret is that this book, and the referenced material do not seem to have a CD version or MIDI version also available that I could find. As a self taught adult I might have labeled this book as 'intermediate' but I have found it to be very useful and enjoyable as an additional practice guide.

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
