The Plain Fame Trilogy is my favorite series ever. This series has crossed over lines to include

readers of all ages and walks of life. In addition, the mix of Amish simplicity and pop star craziness combined with a beautiful love story is sure to cross genre boundaries as well. Plain Again will not disappoint followers of Sarah Price's Amanda and Alejandro. The characters will continue to draw in the hearts of her readers. Personally, I feel like they have become a part of my life. Never before have I been so attached to characters in a story. I love all of Sarah Price's works, but there is something special about the relationship between Amanda and Alejandro. On a side note, I want to also mention how amazing it is that Sarah was able to write book three, being at least as good as books one and two, while fighting a battle with cancer. That alone says a lot about this author.

Amish love stories usually start with a couple in a courting buggy and wind up with a bride and groom sitting in the "eck" with a bunch of celery for a centerpiece. Not this one. Amanda falls in love with Viper, an international hip-hop star she met by accident when his limo ran her down. This third book in the series is about their new marriage, and the tests that fame puts on the marriage vows. Paparazzi hound Amanda's Amish village, camping out at Amanda's family farm. Amanda becomes a celebrity, too, and this takes a toll on the Amish community. This book is a powerful story, and provides a glimpse into the world of the glitterati, the mega-rich, mega-famous Hollywood kind of life where reality is stretched, image is all, and there is a dollar sign on every single bottom line. It also shows the conflict between society and the Amish community. It depicts what happens in a family when a member decides to "go English," and to not join the church. The bounds of love sometimes get strained in this story, but the beauty of it is what occurs because of that. Far from being a Cinderella story where an Amish girl goes from rags to riches with her handsome prince, this is a story where the shine on the princess' tiara might well be a tad tarnished with a dose of reality. I liked this book because of that. The story is well told and moves nicely through its stages as does just about everything Sara Price writes. There is enough clean steaminess in the book to cause deep sighs of delight among those readers who love romance. A surprise in this book is that the Amish are not portrayed as perfect purveyors of forgiveness and kindness. Nobody's perfect, after all. Sometimes, seeing your own group from the outside is a true eye-opener. This becomes true for Amanda as she experiences a change in how old friends and her Bishop treat her. We are treated to a truly human look at a situation that would try the most Christian of souls. The message throughout is that one does not need to belong to a certain religion to find one's right place with God. And even though lovers of Amish fiction usually root for the ones with the buggies and bonnets, this time, we root for the ones who are far from Plain. I loved this book for that reason.

I want to warn anyone who buys this entire series..there is nothing overtly wrong with them. But I hit a day on when each book was on sale for 2 dollars so I thought, what the heck - I bought them all...I got to the beginning of the 4th and thought - why am I reading these. THEY ARE SO REPETITIVE...Yes there is a story line that progresses but the telling of the story involves the same sort of events, the same scenarios...particularly between the two protagonists, over and over and over - sometimes without even a slight variation...I stopped reading because I realized I was bored out of my mind....I think you could have taken all the books and condensed them into one that comprised the length found in about 1 and a half of them...and then you would have had a really good story. Some careful editing could have made this story great, instead it was really just okay. Sorry.

I will begin that there are not enough stars. This book deserves to have 10 stars. Sarah Price has exceeded all of my expectations with this book. She made you feel like you were right there with Amanda and Alex (for short) as they had to basically work out all the issues that were working to keep them apart. When reading this I felt the different emotion that these two people were feeling. This book even had me crying along with Amanda as she had to deal with the hurt and fear of her true soul mate.
