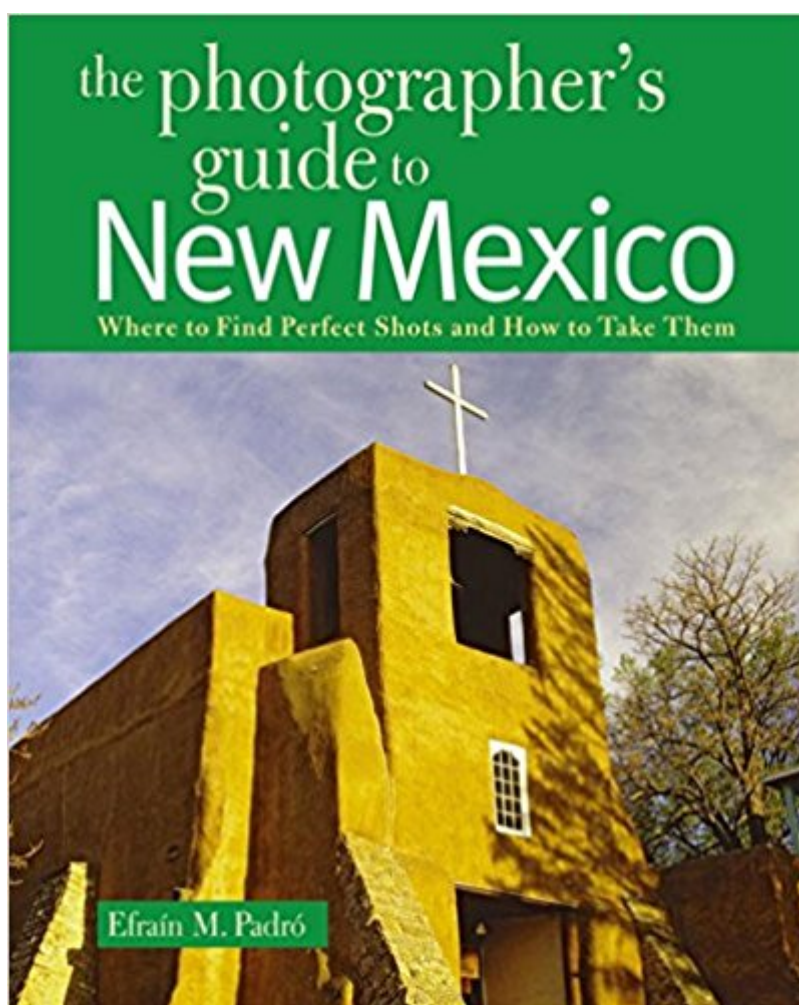

The book was organized very well and easy to use. Excellent photographs in the book. Each site was described, usually with some historical information. Most site descriptions were accompanied by a photograph with helpful hints: (1) best time of day and angle from which to photograph the site, (2) best season of the year to visit, (3) specific directions on how to get to the site.

Great book

There aren't too many books about New Mexico. This book is a great source of information for photographers (where, when and how). I would definitely recommend this to a friend.

We just returned from a 5 day trip photographing New Mexico where we were able to evaluate 'the photographer's guide.' Although the author covers many of the State's major features and offers useful photography tips, he leaves out several other important locales (such as the Valley of Fires, Jemez Caldera, and several wildlife refuges). Overall, I was a bit disappointed with the coverage of the wildlife and landscape features. Unfortunately, much of the book's emphasis is on human activities and does not cover the state's natural features in the depth that I was looking for. The reader will have to rely on other sources for that information. Also, some of the maps provided are misleading and could get the reader into serious trouble. Specifically, the main map shows a east-west road across the middle of the White Sands Missile Range that is not accessible by the general public. Trespassers will be shot (or bombed)! The book offered a good overview, but did not provide the comprehensive description of the State's photographic opportunities that I was looking for. Maybe Volume II will complete the picture? Because of the relatively low price, I felt that I received good value despite its shortcomings.
