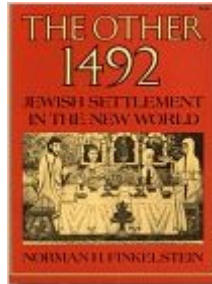

Who rose to power and who got kicked out of the country. I especially loved it because it told a wholly different story than the one you hear in grade school. Loaded with information but simple enough for a grade school student to understand.

If you want a concise, reasonably accurate history of events leading to the 1492 expulsion of Jews

by King Ferdinand and his famous Queen, as well as a tracing of what it triggered on through to settlement of New Amsterdam, then this is for you. If you want details and lengthy explanations, then use its bibliography for finding those references. A good way to open discussions with middle school through adult readers.
