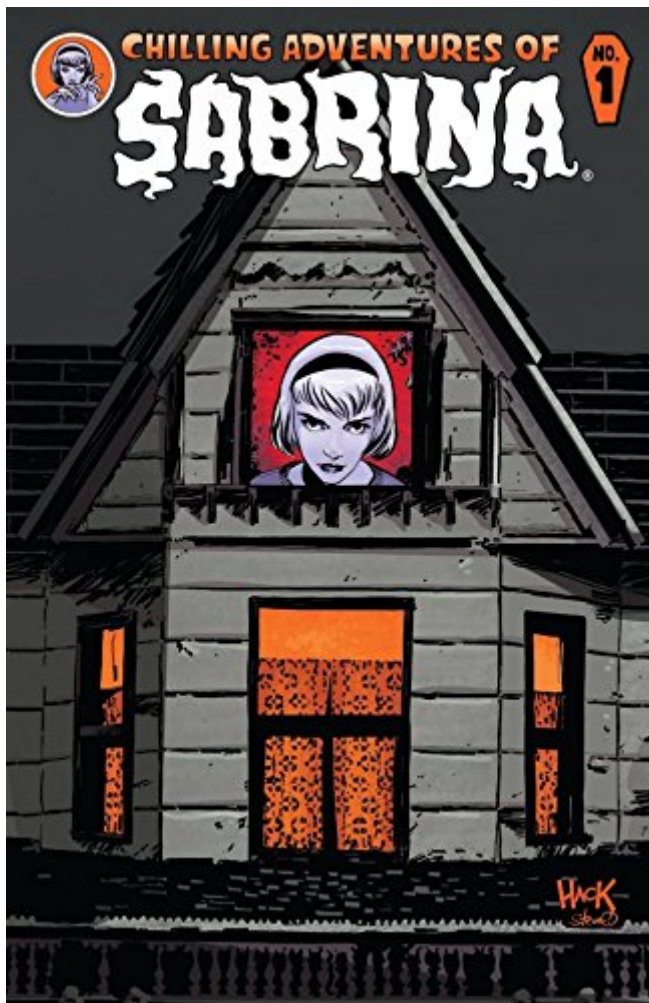

Boy, when the Archie publishers decided to upgrade and reboot the franchise they didn't spare the blood and gore. Archie and his Riverdale pals are all out there fighting zombies and trying to turn

JugDead. Meanwhile, back here at the ranch Sabrina has gotten a new, extremely dark origin story and a body count that makes it very clear that this is no longer your cheerful pre-teen sitcom Sabrina. This Sabrina is half mortal and half witch. Dad has gone missing, mortal Mom is in an asylum, and the demon, Madam Satan, who Dad dumped in order to marry Mom is back in town and looking for revenge. And Sabrina, bless her heart, can't decide whether to attend her unholy 16th birthday baptism in the service of Satan or attend the school pep rally with her boyfriend Harvey. Actually, that's not really fair. This is about 90% dark, witchy, satanic action, and then about 10% school angst added in for humorous and ironic effect. All of that said, Sabrina is still an engaging, appealing and easily likable character. Her two caretaker aunts aren't ditzy anymore. Well, they are but in an evil satanic coven sort of way. And Sabrina's cat is still a wisemouth, so that hasn't changed at all. This is the first book in a six book arc. This one sets out the baby Sabrina origin. Later books follow the movements of revenge driven Madam Satan, Sabrina's messed up baptism, some unfortunate happenings involving Sabrina's friends, and lots of digressions and side bits. The writing is sharp. The art work is top drawer, with solid marks across the board for pencils, ink and color. Some of the full page set pieces are very striking indeed, even as a Kindle Fire download. So, as a kindle unlimited it's easy to sample this issue #1 and decide whether to keep going. I fell for this Sabrina's sneaky spell and ended up going for the full ride. A nice and just very well thought out and presented reimagining of Sabrina.

I haven't read an Archie title since I was in high school. Between ages 12 through 16, my tastes for idealistic and sweet stories switched to the more macabre and psychologically thrilling. My heart knew I'd always love the original classic and colorful characters from the Archie-verse, but I wanted something more. In a bout of boredom and Kindle browsing at 5:00am, I came across this gem. I love the grittiness of the art. I love how the varying personalities are portrayed in the writing. And I love how Sabrina retains an innocence that contradicts the dark air of the world she lives in. I foresee a trip to the comics shop in my future for TPBs for this series. And now that I know about "Afterlife with Archie", I'm curious to reconnect with a darker retelling of good 'ol Riverdale! It's safe to say the creators of this series have casted a spell on me and resurrected my love for the Archie-verse!

I'm very selective with which graphic novels I dedicate time to, both Sabrina's storyline and artwork hooked me quickly. Looking forward to checking out the next issue no doubt. Spoiler.....kinda.....The sketches in the end were awesome to check out.

This is a complete 180 from the show I watched as a kid! It mixes a lot of elements to make it more modern (stylistically) and more historical (it's the 60s!). I'm not in awe, but I'll check out a few more to see where it goes.

Definitely a new insight into the Sabrina/Archie world.... I can say that. I'm not sure I like This version yet overall. But I do appreciate the storyline's beginning. I do appreciate a horror approach.

Haven't read the further issues yet, but this series seems like it has potential. While it's not a straight horror story, it's not kidding when it says it's a much darker take on Sabrina the Teenage Witch.
