The beginning/end covers have lowly worm shaping each letter of the alphabet - this is a great way to start and end the book, with us tracing him/the letter. Finally, gold bug makes a surprise appearance in nearly every page (or every story line/mini chapter). He is even on the cover and in the preface. If you are tired of reading, you can convert reading the whole storybook to just looking for goldbug on every page.
