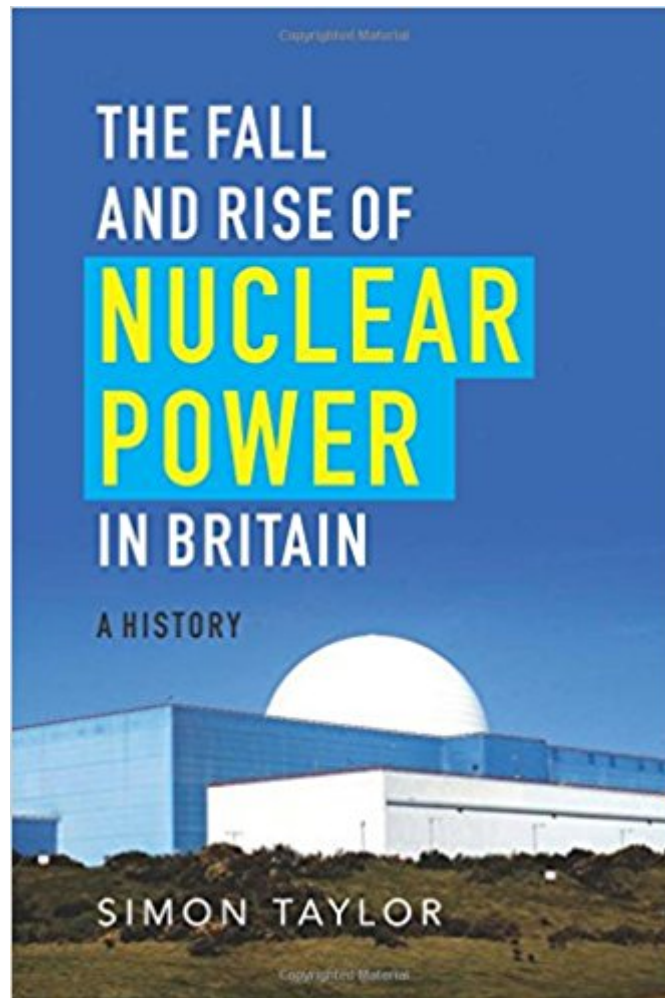




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The Fall And Rise Of Nuclear Power In Britain: A History
