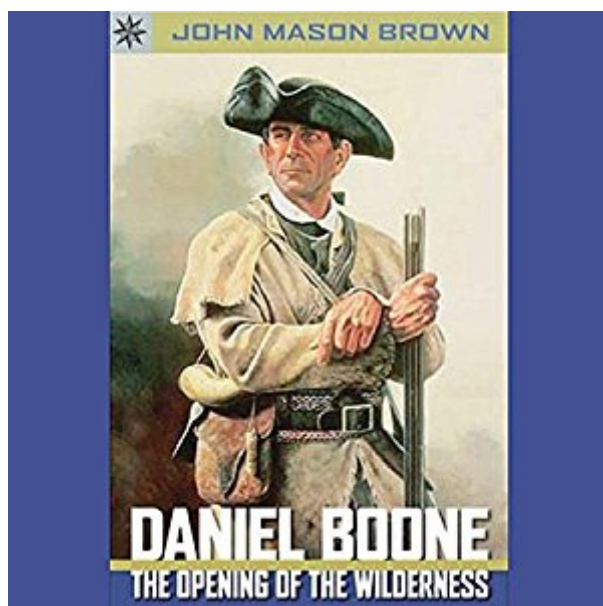


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Sterling Point Books: Daniel Boone: The Opening Of The Wilderness
