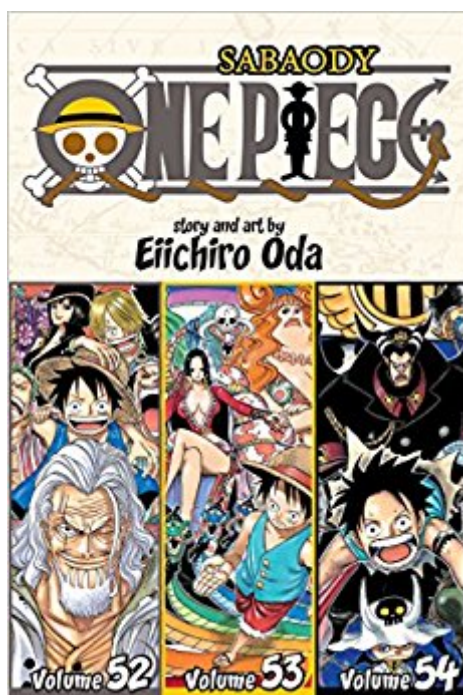


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One Piece (Omnibus Edition), Vol. 18: Includes Vols. 52, 53 & 54

Oda went on to work as an assistant to some of the biggest manga artists in the industry, including Nobuhiro Watsuki, before winning the Hop Step Award for new artists. His pirate adventure One Piece, which debuted in

Weekly Shonen Jump magazine in 1997, quickly became one of the most popular manga in Japan.
