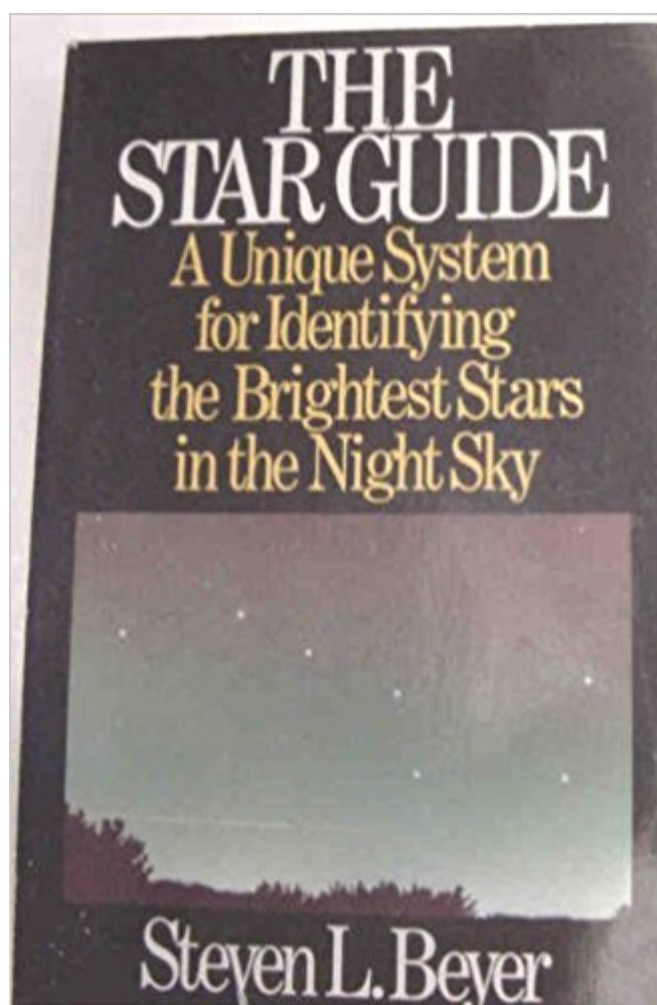


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The Star Guide: A Unique System For Identifying The Brightest Stars In The Sky
