

I am curious about possibly starting to bow hunt, or at least get into archery and the range. I found this a great source of info on archery in general and bowhunting. It opens up a window on the various complexities and interactions of the wide variety of elements that impact and ultimately affect arrow flight.

Its an old book, but a good read.

I am sure this was a decent book once, but unfortunately it is hopelessly outdated. While the beginner will still be able to learn something useful (the laws of physics stay the same after all), the lion share of the book describes equipment, which has changed too much in recent years for something that my guess is was mostly written in the late 90's or early 2000's to be of any use today.

I am retired, and love to read. As a matter of fact I'm reading three separate books right now. This "Traditional Bowyer's Encyclopedia" is actually a compilation of many very good articles by various experts in the field. I'm really learning a lot. I haven't touched a long bow in 40 years, but now that I have the time, I'm planning on getting back into target shooting at the local mountain archery range. These articles are bringing me up-to-date quickly! You'll really enjoy this material.

I haven't read this book from cover to cover yet but have looked through most of it. This is a great book. There is a lot of information for the size of the book.

This book gives a good brief over view of archery and bow hunting. It provides a description of the characteristics of arrows, the different kinds of bows, shooting fundamentals and basic bow hunting strategies. It has sufficient illustrations to communicate the subject and is written so that it is understandable and not with a bunch of technical mumbo jumbo I couldn't understand.

I enjoyed reading this book and it was a pretty good grounding in the basics.. but it is clearly out of date and I would advise readers to turn to "Setting up the perfect hunting bow" as a far more useful source of information. This book is in need of a revision.
