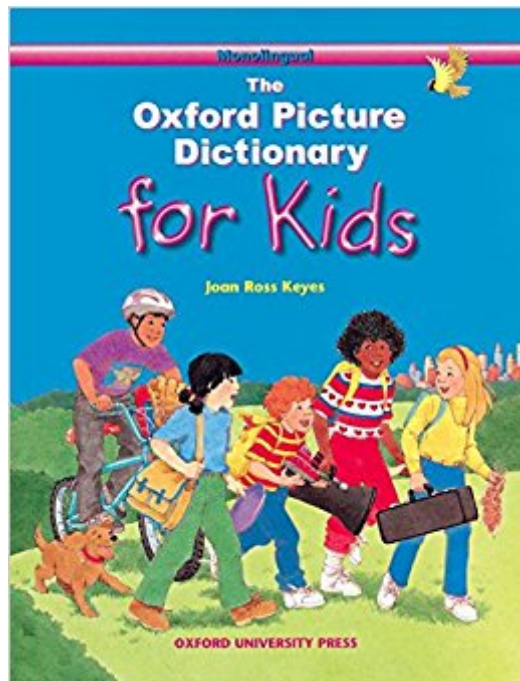

This is a great book for children learning the english language. I am a teacher and we use this book with english language learning students. I just bought this book for a friend who is adopting a 3yr. old from another country this summer to help her in communicating with her and to help her learn the language. Students use this book to communicate with teachers and friends by pointing out pictures of words they want to say. When a student has something that they want to say that is not in the book, we determine what it is and then add a post it note in the book on the correct page so that they can find the word again when needed. For example, one student wanted to say "mittens" but in the book on the Winter page it only had "gloves". We drew a small picture of mittens on a post

it and wrote the word and stuck it on that page next to "gloves". Another example is "recess". We wrote that word out and put it on the page where "playground" was. We use sticky page markers on the edges of pages so students begin to learn where things are in the book and can turn to them more easily. Students also use this book during writing workshop to help them write the words they want to say. I highly recommend this book.

This is very good dictionary for young children. I would highly recommend this to parents of pre K and Kindergarten age children.

This book is a simple picture book with about 10 to 12 words for every two pages (without any real definitions, simply a setting with the right word pasted next to it). Even our five year old found it boring and barely uses it. Do not buy this book unless you have pre-kinder children who are ready to learn different words.

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
