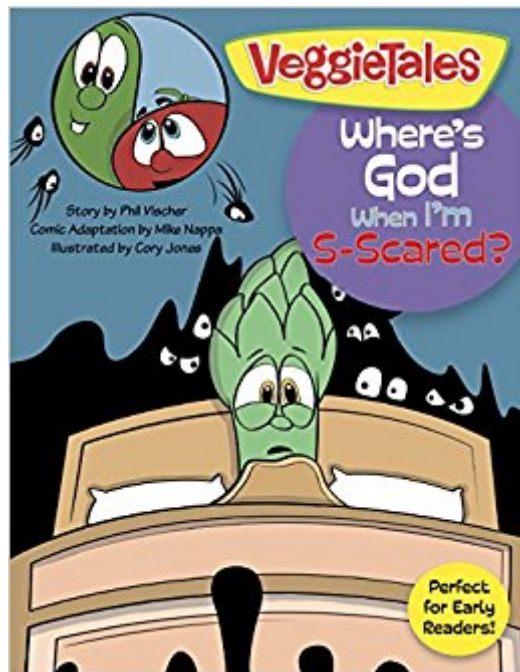


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# Where's God When I'm S-Scared? (VeggieTales)
