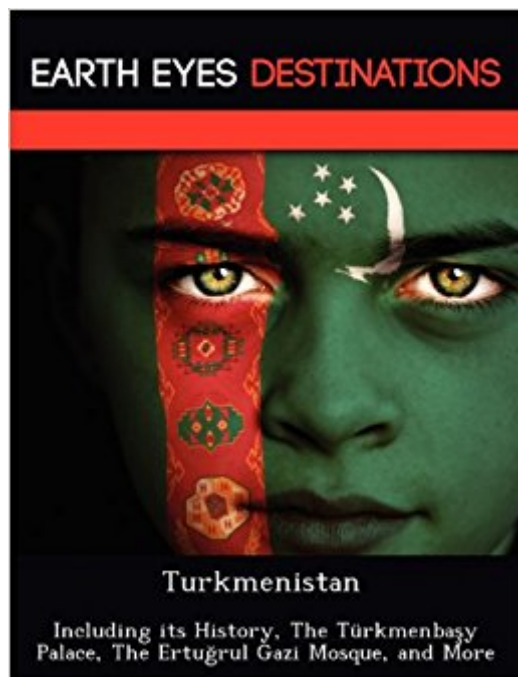




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# Turkmenistan: Including Its History, The Türkmenbaşy Palace, The Ertuğrul Gazi Mosque, And More
