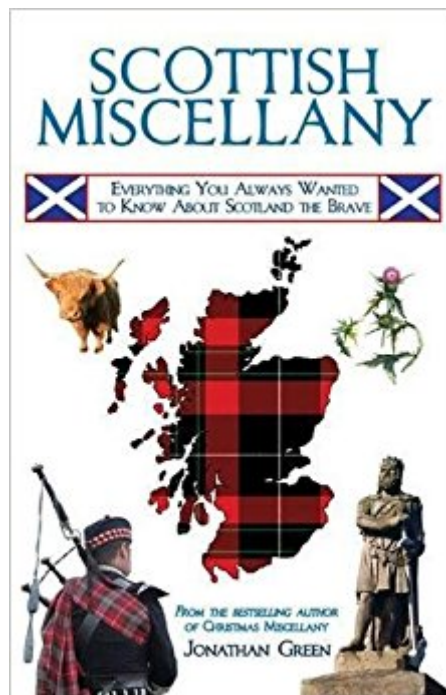




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Scottish Miscellany: Everything You Always Wanted To Know About Scotland The Brave
