

If you are intrigued, you can read all about it. I "read" the kindle version this way, and plan to return to particular subjects for more thorough reading. I also liked the references for further reading on each article, especially when arguments in these references were discussed in the body of the article. Going to these sources was a useful digression! I stumbled upon this book by searching for books authored by the recently deceased ethicist Derek Parfit. Predictably, some of his ideas and arguments are discussed in this collection.

Benatar edits this third edition of analytic existential readings on life, death and meaning. Finally, a contemporary non-continental philosopher who brings analytic skills to clearly and precisely deal with the most profound questions that face humanity.
