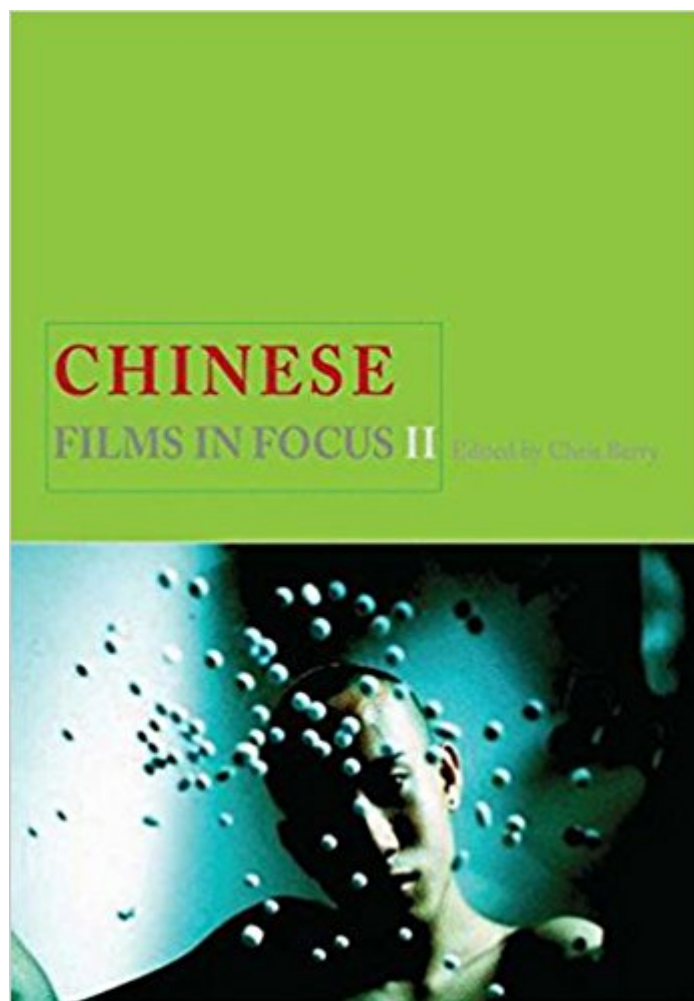

In the film industry, sequels often fail--a miserable wannabe that pales in comparison to the first-born. In contrast, Berry's Chinese Films in Focus II is a successful second take, even though his Chinese Films in Focus I is already a hard act to follow. The quality of the essays in this book varies, but most of them are succinct, accessible, and cogently argued. You've got 34 essays on 34 films (each zooming in on one key issue in one film) from China, Taiwan and Hong Kong. A useful resource for film buffs and students.
