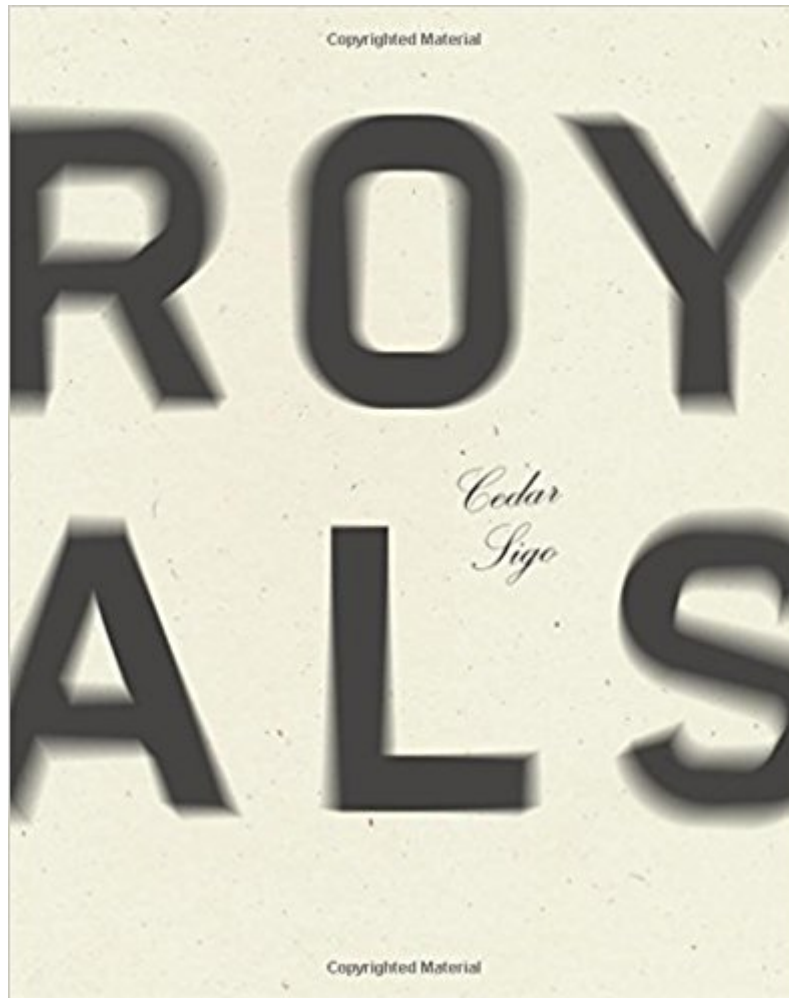

BOMB Cedar Sigo's fourth collection restlessly enacts the pleasures of writing.
