

I love these detailed maps. I have only studied this, not yet used it while traveling. However, I have had great success and enjoyment with the New York version. This California version is helping with planning bigtime!

I love Delorme maps. Great detail and lots of pertinent travel info. If you're just taking the interstate

from here to there you probably don't need it. But if you're on an honest to goodness road trip, if you want to go off the beaten path and see the really great stuff, then don't go without your Delorme map!

A complete a map book as one will find of California. I have a few books of different states. What I appreciate is that it shows maps, roads, public areas and towns without a bunch of advertisements.

Order three gazetteers for a recent road trip, and they were great. Our trip took us on a lot of backroads and I'm not sure we would have found our way without them...even with our GPS. One disappointment was that except for the back cover shot, there wasn't a picture of the whole state, so that you could get the 'big picture' of the area. This was especially frustrating when you were in an area where you were flipping between two (or even three) pages to determine your route.

The DeLorme map series is an expanded scale (1" = 3 miles) map series that does justice to rural explorations but don't fare well on the inner workings of cities. This map is an attempt to fix that. Several pages are dedicated to the downtown city streets in just the largest cities. This map does justice to exploring the less-populated bits, with good detail for getting out of anything you get into. From the sections I've explored, they don't delineate non-public roads from public, which can get you into a bind. You'll still need the USGS maps if you're venturing far from the highway.

Very high quality, and hugely detailed (usually 5 miles to an inch). Lots of additional information for travellers. And you cannot count on uninterrupted GPS access, so such a detailed paper map is a must for us. By far the best one I could find after a lot of looking around.

OK mapGood for those who keep to the roadside services.Campgrounds are limited to the RV and resort types.

Condensing the two maps (Northern and Southern) has resulted in a reduction of map detail. If you compare the older maps to this new one a lot of sites on the maps have been left out.
