

The book seems to be geared more for new Christians rather than those of us who've been believers for awhile. And newer Christians wouldn't get any closer to thinking like Jesus by reading this book, though they might gain some useful knowledge. I wish I had read some of the reviews before buying it. I'm glad I bought it used. Barna does a great job with surveying and analyzing what is going on with modern Christianity. I think he should stick to what he knows best.
