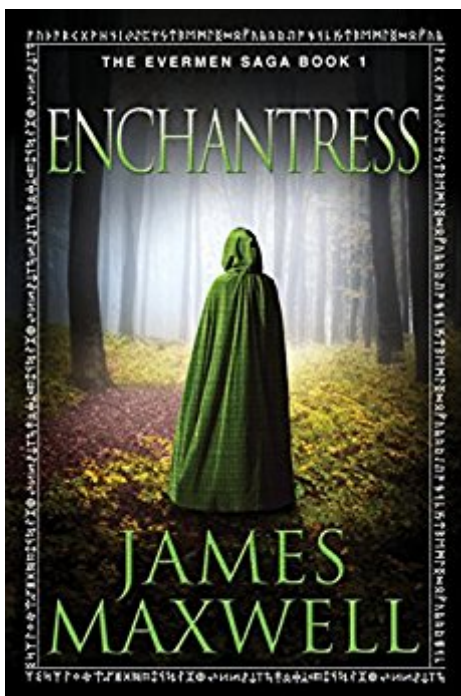

I'm a tough sell, and consider GRRM a fine author based on the complexity of his characters and the fun moral ambiguity. This book's author is NOT GRRM but... despite a few unbelievable "miracles" in the story line and generally simplistic characters this book paints an interesting world with a unique supernatural construct. I suspect the story and characters to grow more complex. I hope so since I just purchased book two :-)

This book caught my attention for the first couple of chapters, then it became boring. I began to realize how boring the prose was and how cliché and boring the main character was. The author is a classic midlevel writer that put all of his work in front of the book so when you read it on you will think its better than it really is.

Can't really finish this book. For one thing there is an incredible amount of violence described in graphic detail. The magic is also somewhat inconsistent - why do the Bladesingers have to constantly chant their runes when other objects just get activated with phrases? There's also some obvious outcomes that you are just screaming at the characters that they should have foreseen or been more suspicious of. Maybe in real life we are often blind to the truth as some of the characters are, but when you are reading a story it's no fun to be yelling at one of them that another character is bad news and why is he/she just blindly going along with them when they are supposed to be a smart thoughtful character. I might try to finish it again later (for the third time), but right now it's going back "on the shelf" indefinitely.

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
