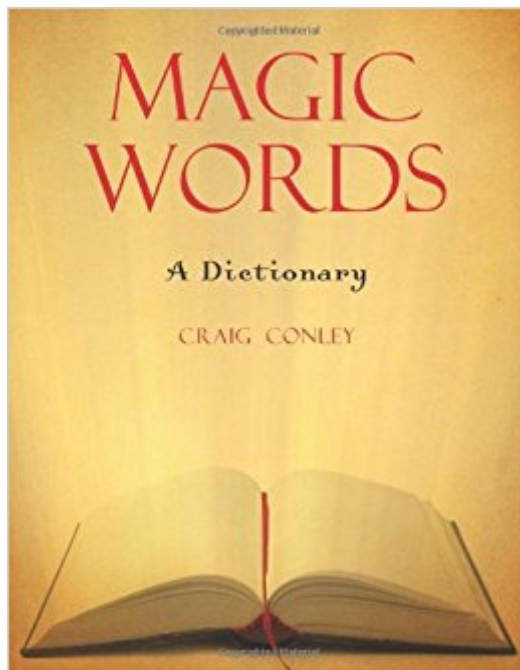

When it comes to his research Craig Conley has often been called a "language fanatic" by gossip

columnist Cindy Adams and a "cult hero" by Publisher's Weekly. His exhaustive research led him to compile *Magic Words: A Dictionary*. He is also the author of *One-Letter Words: A Dictionary* and a regular columnist for *Pentacle* magazine. He lives in Florida and Wales, UK.

I absolutely LOVE this book. It's great if you're interested in magic, but it's really for people who love the sound of WORDS. The evening I received it, I sat on the porch swing to look through it. A half hour later, I discovered that I had been sitting for 30 minutes reading and laughing out loud. There are words and phrases from Ancient Greece to spells from the tv show *Bewitched*! (The yaga zoozie spell was my all-time favorite; it's in the book.) I keep it in my fifth grade class, and use magic phrases as a signal to get to work! I need another copy for home. I also ADORE the literary references. This is a brilliant book for magicians and logophiles!

The book is interesting and well-researched, and good as a starting point for more elaborate research. However my one discovery was that the author's understanding of "Magician" is solely based off the pop-culture understanding (think guy on stage sawing woman in half) Students of serious esoteric movements / paganism / witchcraft will be dismayed to find this. This perspective was expected, but more as a chapter and not the central focus. Magic as a ritualized spiritual practice has virtually nothing in common with "entertainment magic" save some roots. The book would undoubtedly have more academic merit if the dictionary was more focused on etymological/historical origins of magical words. But his sources can be good steps in the right direction.

I've been looking everywhere for this book, even checked big libraries. Now I own it!

It is a beautifully made book printed on nice paper, and appears very informative on the topic. I returned it only because it wasn't the topic I expected, my fault for not reading the description (my fault).
