

Fodor's guides use very few photos so they don't exactly inspire you to travel. However, this book is probably the most up-to-date guide book available on Philadelphia because the other brands of guidebooks do not update their material very often for this particular city. I don't know why most guide books on Philly feel the need to throw in Lancaster and Gettysburg. Those cities are quite far away from Philly and should be treated in their own guide books. Unfortunately, Philadelphia is

practically the only part of Pennsylvania for which you can find a travel guide.
