

One lovely feature of this volume is that it shows the real material that inspired different faux finishes next to the excellent painted imitations. After extensive coverage of all aspects of getting started

(tools and materials, preparation, safety concerns, and design and color considerations), and of working with glazes, there are dozens of detailed recipes for various marble and graining effects. The final chapter, "Professional Practice," explains how to set up your own decorative-painting business, including assembling a portfolio, identifying and reaching your market, financial planning, calculating rates and expenses, preparing samples, organizing the workspace, and working with clients. You'll even find a prototype contract and a checklist of supplies to bring on the job. Those who want to produce spectacular faux-finish results will learn a lot from Professional Painted Finishes.

Even though it uses oils, the techniques for application can be used for water-based paints, but remember, oils give much more depth and translucency than water-based. ALSO, includes chapter on building a professional BUSINESS. Another plus to this book, is it is one of the few that discusses the polishing and finishing of the work. Good price from also.

This is a good guide on how to paint faux finishes. It shows the reader the basics, like using cheesecloth and plastic films to add texture to surfaces and offers color recipes to assist the DIY faux finish painter in the reproduction of realistic wood, stone and other surfaces. I don't regret buying this book.

Whether you are a professional painter looking to expand your repertoire of skills or a homeowner just starting a DIY project, this book is a treasure trove of information. Possibly a bit too detailed for the beginner, it provides the reader with comprehensive information from mixing colors to application processes to using painting techniques to advance a business. If you are just starting out, don't let the sheer volume of information intimidate you. The book can be read in sections, depending on the type of finish you are working on. I found myself reading it from cover to cover simply because it seemed to be easier that way. It's written in a common sense style, and the sequence of the chapters makes sense. I have developed a pretty comprehensive library of "how to" books on painting and finishing, but this has become, by far, my "go to" volume. Well worth it!!!
