This was the last to come and is now one of my sons favorites, his top three at this point are "A Ride Through the Neighborhood", "Goodnight, Daniel Tiger", and this one. Its a pretty long book which he loves and you get to meet the entire neighborhood even Mr. McFeely. The book is a very well made cardboard material and can handle a lot of wear and tear. My son likes to go to bed with a book so we either put this or the Trolley book with him since the wheels move and he can play with it. Overall this is a great book for any Daniel Tiger fan, you meet everyone on the show and have a great time doing it. I would recommend this to anyone looking for a great, children's book.

I got this book for my 18-month-old daughter that LOVES Daniel Tiger. Predictably, she loved this book too! The pages are mounted on a sturdy chipboard - I don't think I could bend them. The tabs on top each showcase a character from the show, which is a feature my daughter loves. She can flip right to her favorite character, whoever it happens to be that day. The pages are bright, colorful and sharply-printed. It's good artwork, right from the show. The story is cute, too and I actually learned some things about the characters, even though I have seen every Daniel episode about 50 times. The only downside to the book is that it's pretty heavy and a little awkward for little ones to carry around.

Daniel as a whole teaches kindness and uses polite words, unlike most kid's shows/stories that present rudeness as funny and cool.

It's very similar to "A ride through the neighborhood" the Daniel Tiger book that looks like a trolley. If you have already purchased that book I would spend your money on a different Daniel Tiger book. If not, its a fun read and honestly my daughter enjoys them both.
