

This is not a full score for piano like I thought, my mistake, but the description is misleading. Nor does it ever really tell you what it is on the inside. I know the music well enough to know at sight what is contained in its scant 28 pages, a suite of course, but there is no identifying factors. Oops.

There is not a piano score of the full piece as titled, only fragments/selections. A full piano transcription exists but this is not it. One star because it's approximately one fifth of the piece.
