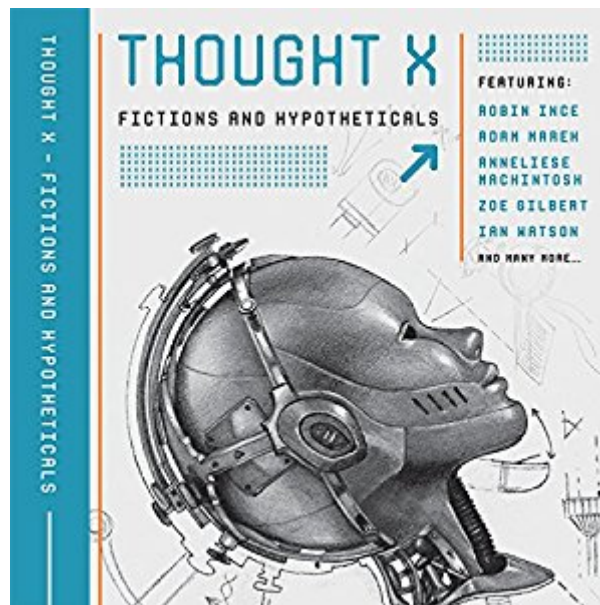

Synopsis

Science is always telling stories.
