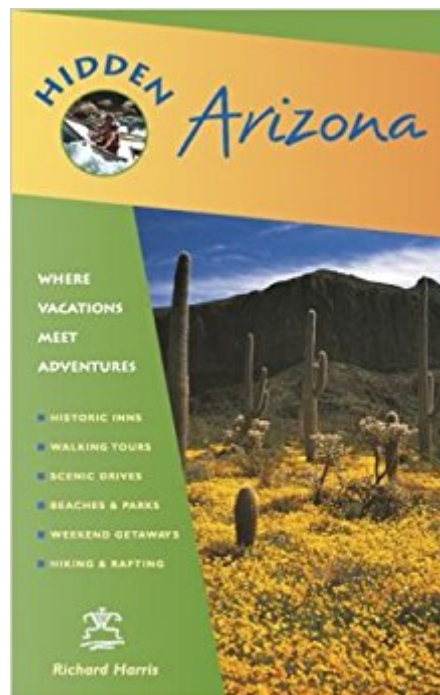

The only things hidden in this book are the few-and-far-between listings for places that can't already be found in the AAA Tour Book. The layout and verbiage are bit more friendly but all in all, I found this guide book to be long on pat advice, (I.E. "Carry extra water when traveling in the desert") and short on usefull tips and interesting destinations. Not bad if you aren't a AAA member or can't borrow the Arizona Tour book from one, but definitely far below my expectations. This will be the first book I've ever returned for credit.
