

Awesome tutorial book on coloring gemstones and it has lots of places to test out and perfect coloring them! If gemstones have always been hard for you to color like they have for me then this book will help!

Love the gems, very good book. The tutorials in the book are useful for the beginner gem colorist. When I am done with this book, will definitely buy another volume.

I bought the book mainly for the written tutorials. The step by step illustrations are in black and white. I didn't find them very helpful since they aren't in color. You can find better color illustrations on the internet for free.

Instructions are not that great in my humble opinion - but they sort of led me in the right direction. The illustrations are very simple and repetitive. Just not what I was hoping for I guess.

For all of you gem lovers out there, here comes volume 2, complete with gem coloring tutorials and gem anatomy. Includes 25 lovely, original, hand drawn illustrations with varying levels of open spaces and intricate detail. The images are full page with enough white space border surrounding them for easy removal for framing and coloring. The lines are crisp and clean and vary in thickness. For those with dexterity or vision issues, there are only a few pages that have some smaller details that you may have to take your time with. Otherwise, you should have no problem with the images in this book. You can use most coloring media on this, but use some blotter pages if using markers to avoid bleed through damage to the next page, and if using watercolors, I recommend copying to heavier weight paper to avoid paper buckling/wrinkling. There are 2 color test pages at the back of this book to test your colors on, or you can also use for blotter pages, if desired. Amanda includes an information page about herself with social media contact links. This book is good for all skill levels.

In this follow-up to Gemstones Volume 1, the artist gives us gorgeously hand-drawn faceted gems AND a full written tutorial, with photos, on how to color them. Her incredible talent shows not only in the art, but also in the colored versions she provides herself on the cover and (in my attached video) on paper. This book is great for colorists of all ages and skill levels, and is more of a "practice manual" to coloring gemstones. I highly recommend it for anyone wanting to learn the skill of gemstone coloring. The author provided me with a copy of this book. I created the attached video to show what's inside the book.

This adult coloring book has the most beautiful gemstone coloring pages in it... There is everything from crown jewels to mandala type jewels. Once you start coloring gems I bet you become a gem-addict just like me :) You can't go wrong with this book...
