

As the previous reviewers have written, the index is terrible. There is also some jargon, but it's not as bad as some management books. I'll get back at it after taxes.

Very good and thorough book on periodontology. I like that the book refers to a lot of studies instead of making its own conclusions on subjects that has not yet been proved. The negative side is that the book is very heavy to read. Sometimes you just want to be presented the facts. Chapters dealing with treatment planning and treatment of periodontitis is based too much on examples and too little on actual guidelines. But all in all a good book.
