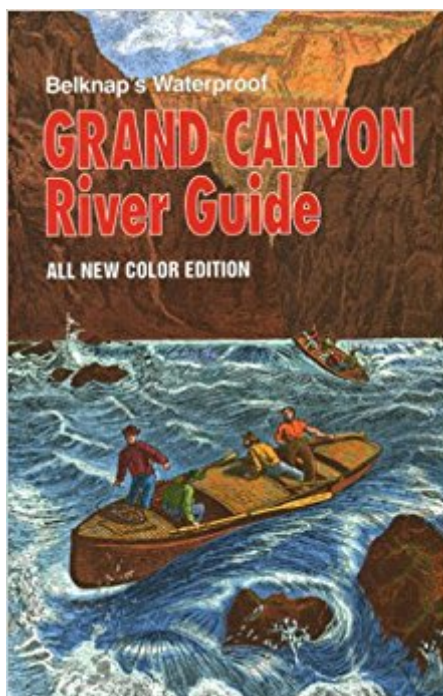

The map is great of the Grand Canyon. This is a older version but in great condition. A newer one has more color. It would be nice if descriptions for this book would include the date of publication. 4 of us took a trip this summer and bought this book to mark our route. Of these books there are 3 different publishing dates.

Very useful before the raft trip - helped me decide what type of raft trip to take, over which half segment (Lee's Ferry to Phantom Ranch best) - and continued to be useful during the raft trip (actually know what looking at and heads up before something of interest passed).
