

More importantly, within the revelations of Mr. Shaw's 7 week sojourn + 2 year post reflections, one gains insight and deeper understanding of how in life, no matter how much technology and advances there are, the simple things in life, a solid core of values and family still mean the most.

Having been to Italy several times I loved reading this book. Gives you an idea of the Italian people and the values they live by. I would recommend this book for sure.

This is a very different account of a journey to six farms in Tuscany to assist the owners with their olive harvest and other tasks in return for board and lodging. The author travels between farms on a bicycle, a unique manner indeed. He meets with very different farming families and analyses their philosophy and beliefs to reach the essence of Italian life. His ideas are most interesting and stimulating, I hope many people read his book and absorb his ideas.
