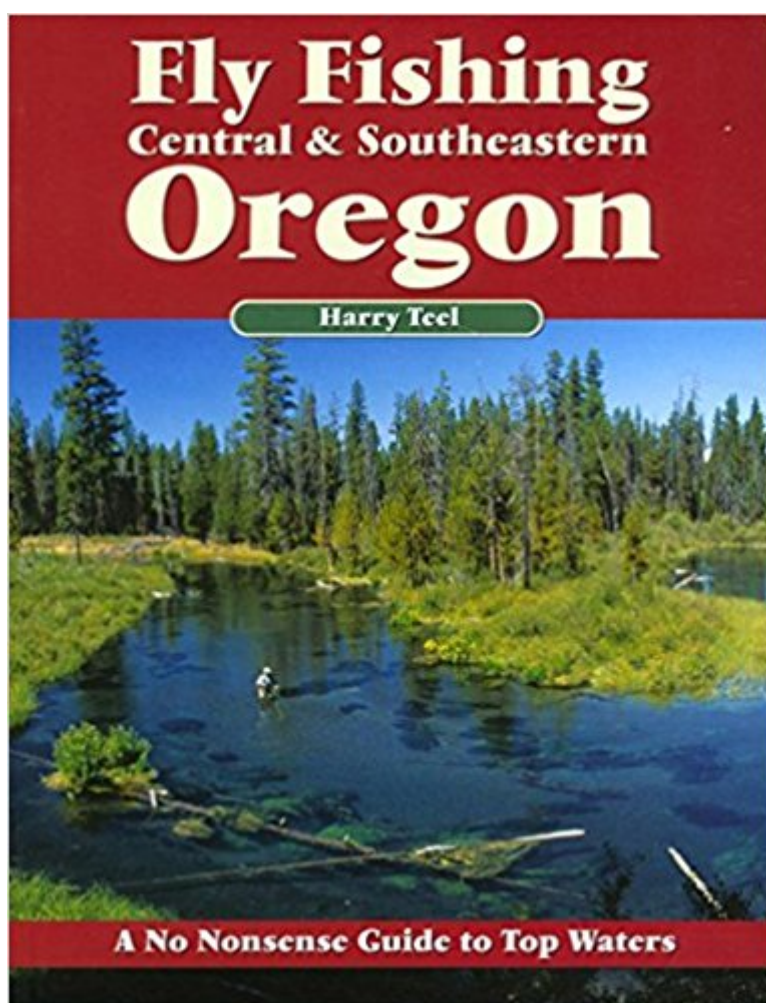

This is the updated and redesigned version of Harry Teel's Guide to Fly Fishing in Central & Southeastern Oregon (1993). It was popular immediately, updated and reprinted five times.

In the early 80's Harry Teel opened and operated The Fly Fisher's Place, the fly shop in the Central Oregon town of Sisters. He's since retired and devotes his time to grandchildren, fly fishing, and pursuing birdies on various golf courses throughout the United States. Jeff Perin updated information and helped with the new waters in the sixth printing of this popular fly fishing guidebook. He lives in Sisters, Oregon, where he owns and operates the Fly Fisher's Place.

This book provides only a very limited account of fly-fishing sites in Central and Southeastern Oregon. It offers no specifics regarding access or locations. A very general guide and not likely to benefit anglers unfamiliar with these areas. All of the information contained is readily available via the internet or a more comprehensive resource such as the Anglers' Guide to Oregon or the various hatch guides specific to the areas. It frankly isn't clear that the authors ever have specifically fished the areas in the book - so general is the information. A disappointment.

Would have liked to see more info regarding high desert streams and small rivers.

Positive: this was a pretty good book, a fair bit of detail and some really nice pictures. Negative: the selection of streams could have been a little broader. As a fishing nut, I would have liked a little more integration of the detail which was in charts into the write-ups rather than separated.

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
